Throughout the month of November, the Church bids us to remember our brothers and sisters who have gone before us in faith to their eternal reward. The month begins with the Solemnity of All Saints. On this day we celebrate our brothers and sisters who faithfully labored in the fields of the Lord and now rest in God's presence. On November 2nd, All Souls, we remember our brothers and sisters who have gone before us in faith and pray that they too will share in the fullness of God's glory.
