Relocation of Sacred Imagery

Some people have asked what happened to...

The statue of the Sacred Heart which was in the Sanctuary is now in the Shrine of the Sacred Heart in the back of the church.

The statue of St. Clare which was in the Monastery side of the Sanctuary was a gift from St. John's in New York. It was relocated to the entrance of St. Clare's Friary. The retirement community did not have a statue of St. Clare and was thrilled to have an image of their patron.

In order to create space for the Shrine of the Sacred Heart:

The 8th Station of the cross was moved forward.

We also moved the 7th Station to create symmetry.

Both are now on the wall opposite the Shrine of Solanus Casey.
