In keeping with our Mass Book Opening Dates

The Mass Book for **January 1 through June 30, 2018**
will open on **All Souls' Day, Thursday, November 2.**

The Mass Book for **July 1 through December 31, 2018**
will open on the **First Tuesday of Lent which is February 20.**

The Bread & Wine And Sanctuary Lamp Memorials
will also open on these dates.

In order to give everyone an opportunity to request their Masses and Memorials, **we ask that you do not request more than six Masses and that only one be a Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass during these six month time periods. To put ourselves in line with Archdiocesan guidelines, the stipend for all Masses will be \$15.00.**

You may also request up to 6 Bread & Wine or Sanctuary Lamps when the Book opens. The stipend for a Memorial will also be \$15.00.

Your cooperation with these stipulations will be appreciated.
