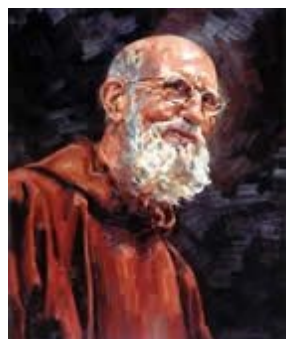

In celebration of Blessed Solanus Casey's beatification, the Secular Franciscan Order of the Sacred Heart Fraternity is inviting all of you this Sunday, November 19 at 1:30pm to the church hall. Our guest speaker will be John Solanus Casey Evans. He is the founder of Book and Spade Ministries, a site dedicated to defending scripture and a biblical worldview through archaeology, philosophy, and science. He is an outspoken advocate for the rights of the disabled, a student of Medieval Studies at Fordham University, and a devout Roman Catholic. He has published several volumes of prose and poetry including his latest work of theology, the Cradled God and is in development on his upcoming novel, the Fugitive from Camelot.

2018 Mass Book

In keeping with our Mass Book Opening Dates

The Mass Book for **January 1 through June 30, 2018** opened on **All Souls' Day, Thursday, November 2.**

The Mass Book for **July 1 through December 31, 2018** will open on the **First Tuesday of Lent which is February 20.**

The Bread & Wine And Sanctuary Lamp Memorials will also open on these dates.

In order to give everyone an opportunity to request their Masses and Memorials, **we ask that you do not request more than six Masses and that only one be a Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass during these six month time periods. To put ourselves in line with Archdiocesan guidelines, the stipend for all Masses will be \$15.00.**

You may also request up to 6 Bread & Wine or Sanctuary Lamps when the Book opens. The stipend for a Memorial will also be \$15.00.
