Street parking for Mass: Please remember on the weekends:

Parking in front of church and 108 Shonnard is front end-in parking. The street is wide enough that you do not have to parallel park on Shonnard.

Parking is also available in the school lot behind the church, on Lewis Ave, and behind the 108 Shonnard building (Old Grade School). Yes, parking in any of these places may mean a longer walk however there are ample spaces with easy excess. If you were to choose the 108 lot, there is a staircase behind the wing of the old grade school that will lead you to Convent Avenue.

I would also like to suggest that parishioners abide by all parking laws such as not parking too close to the corner, on the sidewalk, in a cross walk, or in front of a fire hydrant. To do so is to break the law! If you should receive a ticket for any of the above mentioned violations, or any other traffic violation, you would be liable for the fee. The breaking of a traffic law because you're in church does not exempt you from the penalty that could occur.
