**In keeping with our Mass Book Opening Dates set last year**

The Mass Book for **January 1 through June 30, 2017** will open on **All Souls' Day, Wednesday, November 2.**

The Mass Book for **July 1 through December 31, 2017** will open on the **First Monday of Lent which is March 6.**

The Bread & Wine And Sanctuary Lamp Memorials will also open on these dates.

In order to give everyone an opportunity to request their Masses and Memorials, **we ask that you do not request more than six Masses and that only one be a Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass during these six month time periods. To put ourselves in line with Archdiocesan guidelines, the stipend for all Masses will be \$15.00.**

You may also request up to 6 Bread & Wine or Sanctuary Lamps when the Book opens. The stipend for a Memorial will also be \$15.00.

Your cooperation with these stipulations will be appreciated.

**Prayer Corner**

Harvest time is at hand, and the Lord of the Harvest calls us to reflect on the "End Times." The falling of leaves and the collecting of fruits and vegetables is a gentle reminder that we too will someday be gathered in God's loving embrace and share in the feast of heaven.

Throughout the month of November, the Church bids us to remember our brothers and sisters who have gone before us in faith to their eternal reward. The month begins with the Solemnity of All Saints. On this day we celebrate our brothers and sisters who faithfully labored in the fields of the Lord and now rest in God's presence. We look to their example and pray to them that they might aid us in living our Christian lives.

On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, All Souls, we remember our brothers and sisters who have gone before us in faith and pray that they too will share in the fullness of God's glory.

This year at Sacred Heart we will again create a place of remembrance near the baptismal font, drawing out the connection that it is through the waters of baptism that we are born to eternal life. Enshrined in this place of remembrance will be your All Soul Envelopes and the Book of the Deceased. In the Book of the Deceased are printed all the names of parishioners who have died in the past year. If you would like to enroll the names of your deceased loved ones into the book, please do so by writing their names on the available pages that are specified for this purpose. This Place of Remembrance will be a reminder for us to pray for those who have recently died, and for those who grieve their loss.
