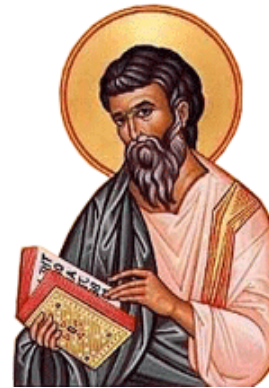

Congratulations to everyone & Good Luck in the Finals.

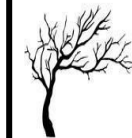
ADVENT WREATHS AND CANDLES
