#### 2018 Mass Book

##### In keeping with our Mass Book Opening Dates

The Mass Book for **January 1 through June 30, 2018** opened on **All Souls' Day, Thursday, November 2.**

The Mass Book for **July 1 through December 31, 2018** will open on the **First Tuesday of Lent which is February 20.**

The Bread & Wine And Sanctuary Lamp Memorials will also open on these dates.

In order to give everyone an opportunity to request their Masses and Memorials, we ask that you do not request more than six Masses and that only one be a Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass during these six month time periods. To put ourselves in line with Arch-diocesan guidelines, the stipend for all Masses will be \$15.00.

You may also request up to 6 Bread & Wine or Sanctuary Lamps when the Book opens. The stipend for a Memorial will also be \$15.00.

My Dear Friends in Christ,

I would like to offer my most heartfelt thanks to those who donated to our Annual Cash Appeal. Contributions amounted to just over \$17,000. If you did not make a contribution yet, I would ask you to prayerfully consider doing so this week or next. As I mentioned two weekends ago, these monies will be used to make improvements to our handicap ramp and to perform some very important maintenance on our pipe organ.

Next Saturday, November 18, along with the entire Church, Sacred Heart will celebrate the beatification of Father Solanus Casey, OFM Cap. As many of you know, Fr. Solanus spent a significant time here at Sacred Heart. In order to celebrate Solanus, as well as to ask for his intercession, we will be celebrating a Mass of Thanksgiving on the day of his beatification. We will use our normal Saturday schedule (3:30 pm Reconciliation; 5:00 pm Mass). At the conclusion of Mass, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. During our time of Adoration, several priests will be available to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation as well as the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Our evening will conclude with Benediction at 7:30 pm. Even if you cannot make it to Mass, please join us for even a few minutes in prayerful thanksgiving for Blessed Solanus!
