 in Christ.

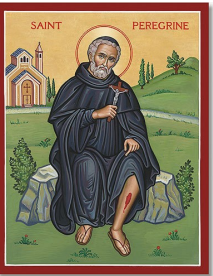
Jesus came so that we might enjoy life – and enjoy it to the fullest. Our
